**CHANGE OF A DRIVER:** Changes regarding a nominated Driver are not permitted after administrative checking is closed (Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> May 2007 at 6:00 pm). A driver change after Registration is closed will only be permitted by the Race Director in case of force majeure and with permission of the Stewards'.

**QUALIFYING DRIVER:** The entrant must record the name of the Driver who achieved the Official "**fast lap**" during qualifying, on the Qualifying Driver form. The Qualifying Driver form must be given to a pit lane official **within 30 minutes** after the end of each qualifying session. The final Qualifying Driver form must also include the nominated Starting Driver. Any changes to the Starting Driver must be submitted in writing to the Race Director and if approved, the car must start the race from the pit lane.
